Introduction

This Cookie Policy (“Policy”) sets out our commitment to detailing how we use our website visitors’ information. This Policy aims to provide detailed information about how and when we use cookies on our website

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer’s hard drive. Cookies can be used by web servers to identify and track users as they navigate different pages on a website, and to identify users returning to a website.

You can set up your web browser to refuse cookies, but this means you won’t be able to book appointments on our website or use all its features.

Information about our use of cookies

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website, it does not identify you personally. This helps us to provide you with a personalised user experience and also allows us to improve our website and advertising.

Cookies We Use

Here are the types of cookies we use on our Website and what they do:

Strictly necessary cookies	These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. For example being able to book a call or appointment through our website.
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Preference Cookies	Preference cookies are used to remember information you have entered or choices you make (such as your username, language or your region) on the website. They also store your preferences when personalising your experience. For example, your preferred language.
Analytical Cookies	Analytical cookies allow us to monitor user behaviour on our Website. This enables us to analyse user journeys and improve the structure of and content on the website. For example, analytics cookies enable us to review how many users have followed specific paths in order to optimise the flow of information.
Advertising Cookies	Advertising cookies are placed on our website by third-party advertising platforms or networks. This is to deliver and track advertising performance, and deliver targeted advertising and extended advertising networks. For example, advertising cookies remember which devices have visited the website.

Disabling cookies
